Neil Armstrong was born on 5<sup>th</sup> August 1930. Neil Armstrong was a famous American astronaut.

Neil Armstrong was 16 when he got his pilot's licence which meant he could fly aeroplanes.

His first trip into space was on the Gemini 8 rocket which took astronauts into space.

In 1969 he was the commander of the Apollo 11 Rocket whose mission it was to take humans to the moon.

He is famous for being the first man to step on the moon.

After stepping onto the moon, Neil Armstrong was heard saying: "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind."

Neil Armstrong died on 25th August 2012.

He is remembered because he was a great explorer and helped us learn more about our solar system.
