
How to identify and approach adults who can help.

Vocabulary

Personal information - Information that belongs to you.

Trusted adult - An adult you believe is honest, reliable and will not do anything deliberatively to harm you.

Permission – Being told by an authority that you are allowed to do a particular thing.

Cyber bullying – Making people feel sad, bad, scared, angry or upset using digital tools (phones, computers or tablets)
